Social Prescription

Social Prescribing is a way which individuals who are utilizing the emergency room or consulting their General Practitioner (or other healthcare professionals) for issues generally considered to be social issues, to receive non-medical supports in the community.

This supports individuals in the areas of physical activity, nutrition, and social engagement as a way of taking control of their own health and enabling them to engage in and contribute to their community.

Eligibility:

- * Experiencing poor health (physically and emotionally)
- * Marginalized
- * Socially vulnerable
- * Making frequent trips to ER or primary care
