Services for Immigrants

Settlement Services

- Information, referrals, support, and assistance to settle successfully in the community
- Assitance completing forms and applications, e.g. medical care card, driver license, social insurance number, citizenship, passport
- Orientation sessions on topics including housing, health care, education, banking, and more.
- Workshops: computer skills, citizenship, and driving test preparation.
- Field trips to local community ammenities, including library, health, education, recreation, and cultural facilities.
- Job search and accompaniment to Employment Services.
- Interpretation and translation.

Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Test (CLBPT)

 The CLBPT English language assessment is utilized for placement into a federally or provincially funded LINC, ESL or other training program that has a language component.

Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC)

- Free English instruction in morning and evening classes, September to June for Immigrants 17 years and older. Application and assessment required.
- Child care for morning classes, ages 0 to 5 years.
- Conversation Circles: Drop-in English practice.
