SETTLEMENT SERVICES

- Information, referrals, support, and assistance to settle successfully in the community.
- Assistance completing forms and applications, e.g. medical care card, driver license, social-insurance number, citizenship, passport.
- Workshops: computer skills, citizenship, driving test preparation, healthcare, banking and more.
- Field trips to local community amenities, including library, health, education, recreation, and cultural facilities.
- Job search, résumé building, and accompaniment to Employment Services.
- Settlement Worker in Schools.
- Interpretation and translation.

LANGUAGE SERVICES

- Free English instruction in morning and evening classes, for Immigrants 18 years and older.
- Child care for morning classes, ages 19 months to 5 years.
- Conversation Circles: Drop-in English practice.

ENGLISH ASSESSMENTS

- CLBPT: Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Tests.
- English language assessment utilized for placement into LINC and provincially funded training programs that have a language component.
