WHO WE ARE

Chilliwack Community Services (CCS) partners with people and the community to create opportunities to enrich lives. As one of the longest standing social service agencies in BC, we provide services to Chilliwack residents at every stage of life and from every background - children, families, youth, seniors and newcomers to Chilliwack. We are a CARF accredited agency, the international gold standard for non-profit excellence. Starting as Chilliwack Community Chest in 1928 and addressing poverty, we have grown to an agency serving 1 in 10 residents in Chilliwack today.

We need your support to help us operate the 39 programs we currently run in our community. CCS supported nearly 12,000 people in Chilliwack, that translates into 1 in 10 residents that receive some type of support from CCS. While we have secured partial funding from the government, we need to raise approximately \$2.7 million in sponsorship, donations and grants annually to ensure delivery of our programs and services.

OUR TEAM

At CCS, we provide services through the dedicated efforts of our 125 professional staff and a strong group of almost 600 volunteers. Our Board of Directors is comprised of 13 outstanding members from our community who are dedicate to the mandate of CCS and bring considerable strengths in governance, finance, fundraising and capital planning. The board oversees the Executive Director, and the Executive Director oversees a management team and the overall staff.



SENIORS TRANSPORTATION AND RIDE SERVICE (STARS) PROGRAM

This year Chilliwack Community Services, in partnership with the Government of Canada's Age Well at Home Initiative, was able to introduce a new transportation program called STARS (Seniors Transportation and Ride Service). STARS features a brand new 12person, wheelchair accessible shuttle bus with a professional driver for seniors who live in Chilliwack. The goal of the program is to provide safe, reliable transportation, so seniors are able to attend medical appointments, social outings and grocery shopping, within Chilliwack and Abbotsford.
