Drone Soccer is a fast-paced, team-based e-sport where students fly drones enclosed in protective exoskeletons inside a netted arena, competing to score goals while learning about aeronautics, drone assembly, coding, and collaboration. The program is part of the Beyond the Bell initiative and will run in select SD33 schools.

With Canada’s growing demand for STEM talent and digital literacy, early exposure to technology programs is more important than ever. Drone Soccer provides students with access to high-demand skills—like drone assembly, coding, and strategic collaboration—in a supportive, school-based setting. By removing cost barriers and offering tech-based engagement through the public education system, the program helps create equitable opportunities for students who may face barriers to traditional extracurricular learning. Funding will support drone kits, competition equipment, staff facilitation, and cross-curricular integration with 3D printing and technology education programs already active in SD33 schools. The program is designed to be inclusive and accessible, with opportunities for students of all abilities—including those who may face barriers to participating in traditional team sports.
